Our Volunteering Opportunities

How many Volunteers are needed and how will they be selected?

Five (5) volunteers will finally be selected from the above academic backgrounds. Applications will be assessed against pre-set criteria, and shortlisted applicants will be invited for a formal selection meeting. The finally selected candidates will be offered the chances.

What will Volunteers do?

The volunteers will work as a team in:-

- 1) Designing marketing and business linkages among identified actors (software, relations patterns) for selected agricultural value chains.
- 2) Supporting in formation and promotion of youth and women rural rooted farming and business enterprises, as well as propos innovative approaches in promoting rural rooted agricultural technologies.
- 3) Supporting in project development and designing by bringing in innovative ideas (sector-specific aspects)
- 4) Attend Business Development networks, including think tank events, international development forums, Market fairs, workshops and seminars to create farmers market opportunities
- 5) Provide technical assistance for value-chain and enterprise development through working with micro, small and medium enterprises, farmers' organizations and other intermediaries in prioritized value chains;
- 6) Liaising with sector-specific stakeholders on current and burning issues and working on the action points for the benefits of beneficiaries.
- 7) Develop software, create and maintain organization databases, update web resources and maintaining network and computing systems.

- 8) Develop plans to prevent, control, or fix **environmental** problems like air pollution, deforestation, etc., and promotion of clean energy in our societies.
- 9) Any other activity as assigned or instructed by supervisor.
